

The main Lewis Falls Trail has been cleared of ice storm debris, however, trees came down and severely damaged the hand rails on the side trail leading to the observation point for Lewis Falls. The side trail to Lewis Falls observation point is **CLOSED** for safety concerns. Signs have been posted at the Lewis Falls Trail access points and the side trail, notifying visitors of the closure.

While hikers can hike the Lewis Fall Trail, there is no safe way to view the falls at this time. There is no simple fix for repairing the broken metal piles and posts that make up the hand rail, so we do not want to project a date when the view point might be reopened to the public. Luckily, there are hundreds of miles of other trails in the park which lead to other water falls or great view points.
